University systems :

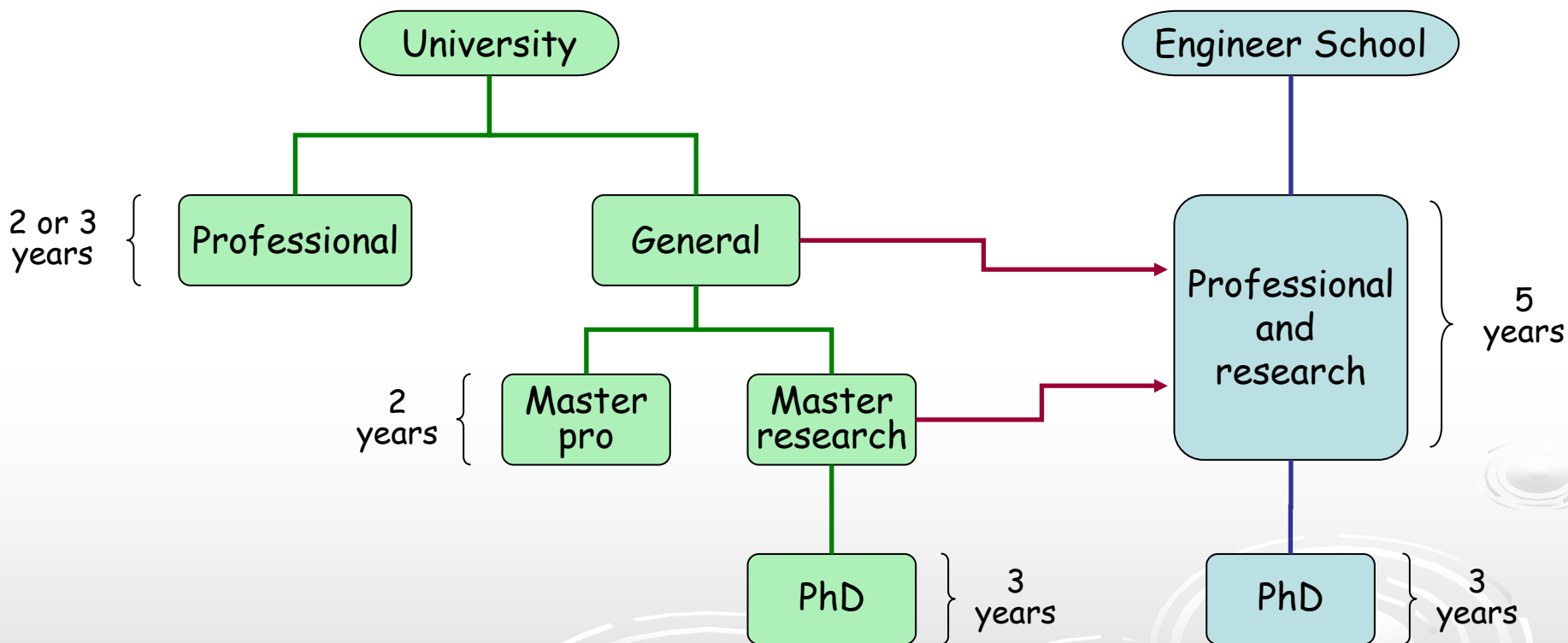
- 80% of 18 years old people can enter a university or an engineer school





University systems :

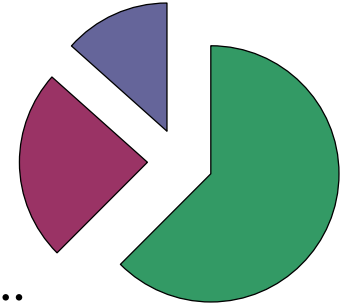
- 80% of 18 years old people can enter a university or an engineer school





Academic research systems in France :

- Ministry of Education and Research : Universities, ..
- EPST (National research institute) : CNRS, INSERM, ..
- EPIC (National research center (commercial activity)): CEA, CNES, ..



Two types of Researcher :

- Assistant/Associate-Professors and Full Professors
- Full researchers (CNRS, INSERM, CEA, CNES, ..)



Everybody working together in Universities / Institutes / Engineer Schools



Composition of a typical group :

- Full Professor, Assistant/Associate-professor, full researcher
- Postdoctoral fellows
- PhD Students
- Master students (M2)

Organization of the group :

- no hierarchically organization
- each students may find his proper way to work





Place in the Lab :

- 1 meter fume cupboard + 2 meters
- 1 desk in an other room next to the lab
